There's no set age limit for the participants at TG. We do however recommend that those who are below the age of 16 to not come alone. It's pleasant for the participant to be at TG with siblings or friends that are above 16, and it will also give you as a parent a stronger sense of safety.

The Gathering has been obliged by the police to make sure that all participants under the age of 16 bring with them a signed consent form from their parents. This is necessary to show that they are allowed to partake in the event.

A signed copy of this consent form is to be shown upon entry. Unfortunately, we have to turn away those who fail to show this signed document.

You as parents know your child best, and it is therefore up to you to decide if your child is suited to attend. The organization has no means to follow up on whether or not your son or daughter is getting enough sleep, keeps up with hygiene or eats enough.

Take a moment to evaluate if your child is capable of maintaining the above, or if it's a good idea to have them travel together with someone older.
